


Common Edits

- **Rotate** – Turn photo taken vertically so you can see it correctly on the screen. 
- **Changing the Mode** – Changing a photo from color to grayscale (B&W) or sepia (brown tones like in the tintypes from the cowboy days).
- **Cropping** – Removing sections of the picture to improve composition (getting rid of unwanted parts of the picture). 
- **Red Eye** – Click to remove the red eye from people.
- **Cloning** – Exactly copying and pasting something from the picture into another place in the same picture (adding grass to a bare spot). 
- **Brightness/Contrast** – Changing a picture that is too dark or too light so that it is more attractive. 

Common Enhancements

- **Effects** – Add edges (frames like bevel, 3D, textures, etc. 
- **Filters** – Artistic (charcoal, watercolor, colored pencil), blur, distort, texture, etc.
